



Applying to Graduate

Appalachian State officially began a new deadline for applying to graduate in Fall 2014. Under this policy, students must apply to graduate THE SEMESTER PRIOR TO THEIR LAST SEMESTER in which they are taking courses.

Many people are confused by the graduation/commencement terms. The difference is as follows:

GRADUATION: The official date that all degree requirements are **completed**. All general education, major, minor, certificates, internships, incomplete grades, etc. must be COMPLETE. Graduation happens three times per year: May, August, & December

COMMENCEMENT: The ceremony to celebrate a student's achievements. Commencement only happens twice per year: May & December.

Students must apply for the term in which they will graduate, not the term in which they will participate in commencement. The table below may help you answer your students' questions about when to apply and for what term .

**Students completing all coursework in August may choose to walk in the December commencement ceremony; however, students applying for August graduation will have their names appear in the May Commencement Ceremony program. Contact the dean's office for information.*

- ◇ Students should make sure all majors, minors, and certificates are listed correctly on their DegreeWorks **prior to** applying to graduate. Students must apply for each curriculum.
- ◇ Students are charged a \$15 fee each time they apply to graduate.
 - If a student applies to the wrong term, he/she must contact the graduation unit via email to graduation@appstate.edu and request that the wrong application be removed. The student must then reapply for the correct term.
